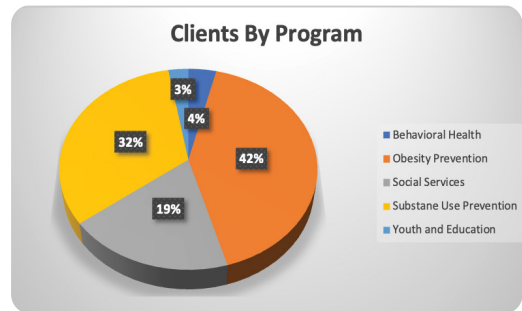

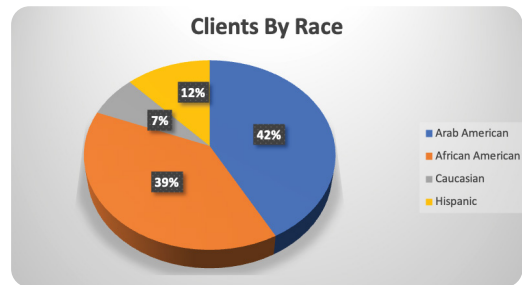

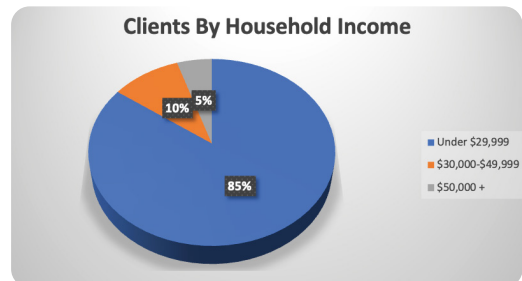
CLIENTS BY RACE

Hispanic.....	12%



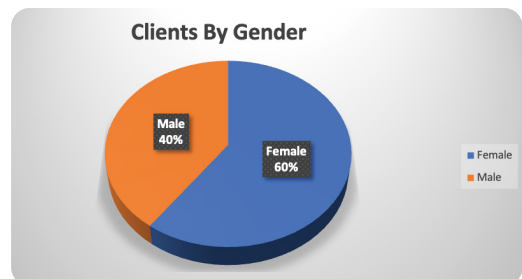
CLIENTS BY HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Male.....	40%

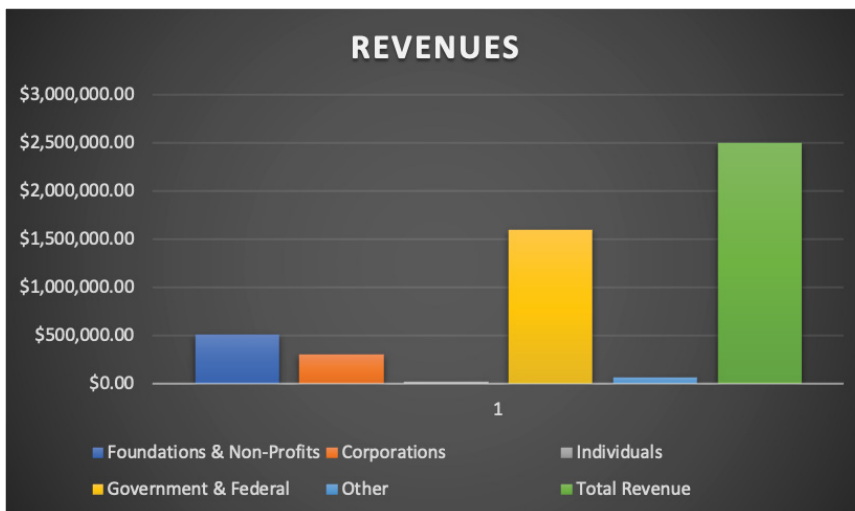
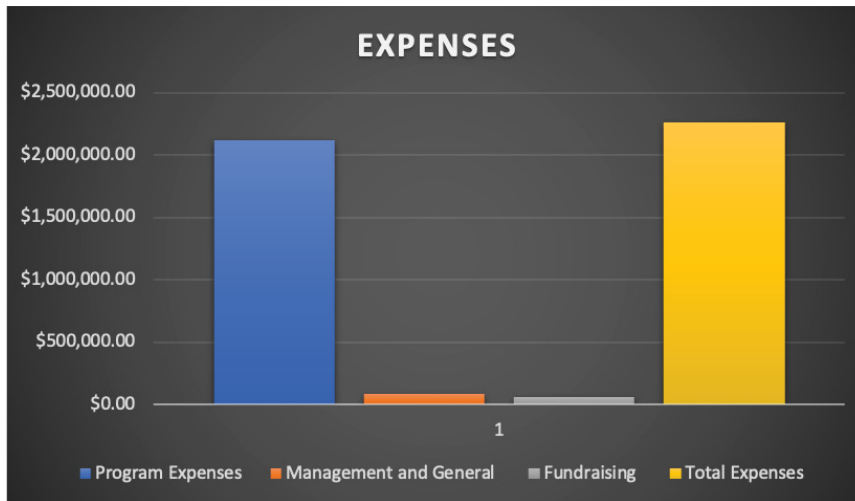
